choicesm program

The *choicesm* care plan (*choosing homecare over institutionalized care environment*) offers home- and community-based services, both acute and long-term, as an alternative to nursing home care. Qualified individuals receive a wide range of services, such as Meals on Wheels, pharmacy, assistance with daily tasks, health care, and intensive care management, so they can live independently at home. Members can keep their own primary and specialty physicians and receive services at the hospital of their choice. Through the *choicesm* program, some nursing home patients are able to return home - where they want to be.

Neighborly Care Network works directly with the Florida Department of Elder Affairs (DOEA) and the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) to provide its members with long-term care.

Eligibility

Individuals who are interested in becoming members of the *choicesm* care plan must:

- be age 65 or older
- have Medicare A&B and be eligible for Medicaid
- live in Brevard, Broward, Citrus, Dade, Hernando, Hillsborough, Indian River, Manatee, Martin, Orange, Osceola, Palm Beach, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, Sarasota, Seminole, or St. Lucie County
- meet financial requirements determined by the Department of Children and Families
- meet clinical criteria for being at risk of nursing home care

Answer phones and provide clerical assistance.

adult day services

A positive approach to self-directed care through wellness, health and social programs for seniors with special needs. Our programs also provide much needed relief to caregivers who are stressed from daily caregiving duties. Adult day care can be a viable alternative to assisted living.

Services include:

- Health and medication monitoring by a Florida-licensed nurse
- Maximization of abilities thru physical/mental stimulation
- Assistance with personal care
- Nutritious meals - breakfast, lunch and snacks
- Therapeutic activities, e.g., arts, crafts, music, games
- Specialized services for victims of Alzheimer's disease
- Intergenerational program
- Transportation available

Centers are licensed by the Agency for Health Care Administration. State and federal regulatory agencies screen all staff members.

Available seven days a week in the privacy and comfort of the patient's home (physician's order required)

- **Skilled Nursing** - Development and implementation of an individualized care plan
- **Therapies**
 - **Physical:** assistance with muscle, nerve, joint, and functional disabilities
 - **Speech:** help with speech, hearing, and language disorders
 - **Occupational:** evaluation of functioning level by applying diagnostic and prognostic procedures
- **Medical Social Work / Home Health Aides** Assistance with long-term care planning and community resources / assistance with bathing, dressing, personal hygiene, and range of motion exercises

transportation services

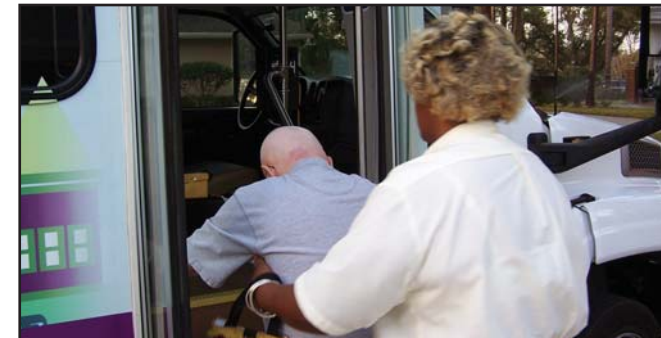

As our senior population continues to enjoy an improved quality of life, the need for transportation services grows more important each day.

Neighborly Transportation answers this critical need. The professionalism and compassionate care provided for our riders each day shows our continued commitment to safe, reliable transportation with courteous service.

- Services are available Monday-Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. (excluding Neighborly holidays)
- Group rates are available if services are required at other times

Our drivers are trained to meet the needs of each rider, including the visually and hearing impaired. Drivers are also trained in CPR and emergency procedures.

Neighborly vehicles are designed to accommodate the special needs of our riders who use wheelchairs, walkers, canes, guide dogs, and other mobility aids. Vehicles are provided with seat belts, first-aid kits, fire extinguishers, and other safety equipment, and are also equipped with wide entrance doors, wide aisles and handrails.

Need transportation? Say ... to the grocery store, a friend's house, a shopping mall, or even a movie theater? If you're 65 and older, or 55 and older and are disabled, you qualify for the EZrideSM program. This transportation service is offered in Pinellas County with destinations that include southern Pasco, as well as specific areas in northern Hillsborough (e.g., H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center, the VA Hospital/Medical Clinic, and the University of South Florida Medical Clinics).
