Neighborly Care Network, a private, not-for-profit organization headquartered in St. Petersburg, Florida, has served the elderly and their families in Pinellas County for nearly 44 years.

A pioneer in elder care, Neighborly provides wellness, health, and social programs for older persons with special needs, helping them to remain independent and in their own homes. This also lets working caregivers keep their jobs while allowing their loved ones to live at home. Our goal is to prevent nursing home placement until absolutely necessary.

Background

- On April 20, 1966, Neighborly (then called “The Neighborly Center, Inc.”) was chartered to study and fulfill special needs of the elderly in Pinellas County. **Today, Neighborly’s 155 employees continue to carry out our mission.**
- In 1968, Neighborly opened the nation’s first adult day care center and started the first federally funded Meals on Wheels program. **Today, Neighborly operates five adult day care centers and delivers an average of 1,600 nutritious meals per day to the frail and homebound.**
- In 1970, the agency developed a volunteer program to help meet the growing needs of the elderly in the community. **Today, approximately 1,200 Neighborly volunteers bring the human touch to the lonely and isolated.**
- In 1973, Neighborly started a Senior Dining program where individuals not only receive nutritious meals, but they socialize with their peers as well. **Today, Neighborly has 16 Senior Dining sites throughout Pinellas County.**
- In 1977, Neighborly implemented a Transportation program whereby specially equipped vehicles take seniors to medical facilities, adult day care centers, senior dining sites, grocery stores, etc. **Today, Neighborly operates 45 vehicles that help individuals maintain their independence.**
