### **Neighborly Care Network Appoints New Medical Director**

He is currently affiliated with Mease Hospital Dunedin, Mease Hospital Countryside, and Suncoast Hospital.

“Dr. DiLella was appointed medical director because of his strong background and focus on the needs of his senior patients,” said Cyndi Hill, director of Medicare Home Health for Neighborly Care Network. As medical director of the Neighborly Medicare Home Health and *choice*<sup>sm</sup> programs, Dr. DiLella will guide future expansion of the program. He will also assist in raising public awareness of senior issues such as malnutrition and memory-related disorders, and their link to other serious health problems.

The Neighborly Medicare Home Health program is available to clients needing skilled services intermittently (requires a physician’s order). Coordinated and supervised by a registered nurse, these services are offered 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, in the privacy and comfort of the

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client's home. The program is Medicare certified and licensed by the Agency for Health Care Administration.

The *choice*<sup>sm</sup> Program (Choosing Homecare Over Institutionalized Care Environment) offers home- and community-based service, both acute and long-term, as an alternative to nursing home care.
